Managers & Officials

Studley FC Managers and officials (including coaches, assistant managers, drivers, lines persons) must follow these guidelines:

-  Managers and officials must respect the rights, dignity and worth of each player and treat them equally.
-  Managers and officials must place the well being and safety of each player above all other considerations, which will include the development of that player.
-  Managers and officials must adhere to the guidelines laid down by the Football Association.
-  Managers and officials must not exert undue influence to obtain any personal benefits or rewards.
-  Managers and officials must encourage players to accept responsibility for their own behaviour and performances.
-  Managers and officials must ensure that any activities they direct are suitable for the ages, maturity and ability of the players concerned.
-  Managers and officials should clarify exactly what is required from the players from the outset.
-  Managers and officials should advise the players of what they are entitled to at the outset.
-  Managers and officials should fully co-operate with other coaching specialists, officials, doctors and parents with regards to the best interests of the players.
-  Managers and officials must always promote the positive aspects of Football.
-  Managers and officials shall not condone the use of abusive/inappropriate language along with violence.
-  Managers and officials should always set the benchmark standards of behaviour and appearance.
